
EDITORIAL PREFACE

The current, 83rd volume is the second one which was published both in online and printed forms (with accepted papers published online continuously throughout the year at folia.nhmus.hu). Here we take the opportunity to share some experiences and further developments related to the online publication.

The continuous online publication is a major achievement for the journal by allowing rapid publication possibility for the authors at any time of the year. To our experience, its advantage has not yet been fully taken by the authors. For many years the manuscript submissions tended to accumulate in late autumn, which habit was adjusted to the printed publication of the volume, however, it has not yet been fully changed by the possibility of the continuous online publication. We understand that old habits are subject to slow change, nevertheless we encourage the authors to take benefit of this development, and to support the journal and the work of the editorial team with more balanced submissions throughout the year. Regularly published new papers result a higher interest for *Folia entomologica hungarica* by the international entomologist community.

As it was announced in the previous volume, online papers including nomenclatural acts are registered in *ZooBank*, the Official Registry of Zoological Nomenclature (zoobank.org) and archived at *Zenodo* digital repository (zenodo.org) by the editors in order to comply with the requirements of the International Code of Zoological Nomenclature. However, published papers which do not include nomenclatural acts are also archived at *Zenodo*, because this digital repository is indexed by the OpenAIRE (openaire.eu), an international network of open access repositories, archives and journals, therefore significantly higher visibility and accessibility are gained for the papers published in *Folia entomologica hungarica*.

We would like to express our gratitude to the authors of this volume for supporting *Folia entomologica hungarica* by publishing their results in this journal. We hope they are satisfied with the great care for their manuscripts expressed by the editorial team, and with the outstandingly quick publication process. We are exceedingly grateful to the scientific advisor of the journal, Dávid Rédei (National Chung Hsing University, Taiwan), and to the scientific and linguistic reader, Balázs Tóth (Hungarian Natural History Museum), for their valuable and precise work in the publication process, which we could always rely on.

We kindly encourage the regular and new authors to submit their works to *Folia entomologica hungarica*, and ask them to thoroughly study and carefully follow the *Instructions to authors* (available at folia.nhmus.hu) before manuscript submission to avoid unnecessary delay in the otherwise rapid publication process.
